Holy Family Cheerleading and Color Guard Uniform Agreement

PLEASE AIR DRY UNIFORMS, NO HEAT DRYERS – WASH UNIFORMS DURING THE SEASON

The student athlete and her parent(s) / guardian(s) agree to accept a set of Holy Family uniforms and hanger for use during the cheerleading and color guard season with the understanding that they are responsible for the proper use, laundering and return of the uniform set and hanger at the end of the season.

The student athlete and her parent(s) / guardian(s) agree to pay a replacement fee of \$65.00 to Holy Family Athletics for any uniform that is damaged or not returned at the end of the season. Reasonable wear on the uniform is not considered damage. A fee of \$5.00 will be charged for any hanger that is broke or not returned.

The issued uniform is to be worn during official Holy Family cheerleading and color guard events by the student athlete to whom they were issued. Do not wear the uniforms to practice or loan to any other athlete. Your coach will collect all uniforms at the end of the season.

UNIFORM DOs

- DO - Use mild detergent
- DO - Launder soiled uniforms immediately according to care labels. If immediate laundering is not possible, hang uniforms on hangers provided so they are not piled damp.
- DO - Follow care labels provided in uniforms
- DO - Store uniforms in a cool, dry area protected from sunlight and fluorescent light to prevent mildew or yellowing.
- DO – Turn uniforms inside out when washing

UNIFORM DON'Ts

- DON'T – Launder in water hotter than 110 degrees. These conditions can release dyes
- DON'T – Wash colors with whites
- DON'T – Bleach
- DON'T – Pile or bag soiled or damp uniforms together. This can cause staining from the dyes and possible cause permanent damage
- DON'T – Allow uniforms to remain in the washing machine after the cycle has finished. This can allow the colors to bleed
- DON'T – Dry uniforms on high heat, this can result in uncontrolled shrinking of the uniform
- DON'T – Iron or press uniforms
- DON'T – Wash with zippered clothes or anything that can snag and pull the uniform material
- DON'T – Dry clean
