



HOLY FAMILY PARISH SCHOOL TUITION & FEES FOR 2017-2018 GRADES K THROUGH 8

It costs over \$7000 to educate one student. Holy Family Parish strongly believes in supporting Catholic School education for all children and subsidizes part of the costs to keep Catholic School education affordable.

Tuition:

Rates for Practicing Catholic Parishioners

An active parishioner is defined as someone who regularly attends Mass and is able to document their financial support of the parish.

Parish Members	\$4,440 one child	\$85.50/week or \$370.00/month
	\$6,240 two children	\$120.00/week or \$520.00/month

*Each additional child \$1,500 add'l. \$30.00/week or \$125.00/month

Rates for Non-Catholic, Non-Parishioners, or Non-Practicing Catholics

Non-Parishioners	\$4,940 one child	\$95.00/week or \$412.00/month
	\$7,240 two children	\$139.50/week or \$603.50/month

*Each additional child \$ 2,000 add'l. \$38.50/week or \$167.00/month

Payment schedule is based on 52 weekly or 12 monthly payments start July 1, 2017.

IF THE ENTIRE YEAR'S TUITION IS PAID IN FULL BEFORE THE FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL, THERE IS A 3% DISCOUNT ON TUITION.

REGISTRATION FEE: \$125 per family (non-refundable) Payable upon registration.

TUITION ASSISTANCE

Tuition assistance will be based on the Peoria Diocesan guidelines using the FACTS aid assessment process. Scholarship applications with supporting documents need to be submitted online by **March 15, 2017**. Please see the **FACTS** insert in the packet for more details.

All monies raised through participation in the Scrip program will be credited to the family's tuition account in September.
